### Officer Involved Shooting

This morning at 7:37 a.m. officers from the Beaverton Police Department were dispatched to a call of a man with a handgun. The man was reported to be on the roof of 2030 SW 170<sup>th</sup> Ave and was agitated, waving the gun and pointing it into the residence and towards the street. This residence is directly across the street from Beaver Acres Elementary School and a short distance from Merlo Station High School. These schools were both put into a lockout at 7:40 a.m. and advised of the incident.

Officers arrived on scene within minutes and attempted to talk with this subject. He was still on the roof and had the gun in his hand. He refused to speak with officers, pointed the gun towards officers, and then fired one round into the house. At this point two Beaverton Officers fired their weapons to stop this active threat.

Officers entered the residence to get to the subject, who was still on the roof. This was done to secure the scene and determine his injuries. The officers began to provide lifesaving efforts and called emergency medical services to provide him medical treatment. The subject is identified as Douglas Michael Smith, 51 years of age and he was pronounced deceased by medical staff at the scene.

This incident is being investigated by the Washington County Major Crimes Team. Both of the involved officers will be placed on paid administrative leave per department policy and countywide officer-involved shooting protocols.
