## **Beaverton US Bank Robbed**

On 070109 at 10:24 am the Beaverton Police Department was dispatched to a bank robbery at the US Bank 4505 SW Hall Boulevard, Beaverton. It was reported that a subject had gone inside the business with a demand note, leaving with an undisclosed amount of money.

Witnesses described the suspect as a black male adult, approximately 5'11", medium build, wearing some type of white head covering or hood over his head but not his face. It was explained that when the suspect entered the bank he gave the teller a demand note, with which the teller complied, and then he quietly left. The bank employees immediately called 911.

As the Beaverton Police were searching the area one officer noticed a person matching the suspect's description. But when the officer tried to contact that subject he ran into a nearby apartment complex off SW Lombard Avenue and entered one of the apartments.

The Beaverton Police Department established a conversation with the subject, who cooperated, and agreed to peacefully come out of the apartment. He was taken into custody, under probable cause, and is being interviewed. However, it's still unknown as to the extent of this person's possible involvement.

The Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) and Beaverton Detectives are working together on the continuing investigation. No additional information or video is available at this time. Any future questions should be directed to the FBI's PIO.
