Beaverton Police Department Seeks Convicted Kidnapping Suspect Who Failed to Appear in Court

Beaverton, Oregon – The Beaverton Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in locating Over Ochoa-Lopez (DOB 05/03/1998), who was convicted of *Kidnapping in the Second Degree* but failed to appear for the final day of his trial.

On September 17, 2023, Ochoa-Lopez was arrested near SW 170th Avenue and SW Tualatin Valley Highway in Beaverton after picking up a six-year-old girl and taking her into his apartment. The child was able to flee, and the Beaverton Police Department was notified shortly after.

On August 21, 2025, a Washington County jury found Ochoa-Lopez guilty of kidnapping in the second degree. However, Ochoa-Lopez failed to appear in court for the final day of his trial and is currently outstanding. A warrant for his arrest has been issued.

Ochoa-Lopez is known to frequent the Beaverton and Hillsboro areas. Despite ongoing efforts, he has not yet been located.
