### Two Stolen Vehicles Recovered. Suspect Arrested

On October 30, 2018 Beaverton Police officers arrested 47-year-old Laramie John Mayes for multiple crimes associated with two stolen vehicles.

At 7:48 a.m. on Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> Beaverton Police Department received a report of a stolen vehicle, a white 2017 Nissan NV van, which occurred 2-3 minutes prior near SW Gem Lane/SW Cedar Hills Blvd. Officers immediately searched the area and located the Nissan in a secluded area behind businesses near SW Walker/SW 123<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Mr. Mayes was seen near the Nissan unwrapping boxes that had been inside the vehicle. Mr. Mayes noticed a patrol officer and fled the scene on foot.

Mr. Mayes was seen getting into a second stolen vehicle, a gray 2012 Mazda 3, by another patrol officer. That officer tried to stop Mr. Mayes but he fled the scene in the Mazda which also had stolen license plates from a different vehicle. Mr. Mayes is believed to have arrived in the area using the Mazda. Mr. Mayes then parked the Mazda behind the Dollar Store located near SW Walker/SW Cedar Hills Blvd. Mr. Mayes was seen by patrol officers in the Dollar Store and was taken into custody.

Officers recovered stolen property from inside the Mazda and will continue to locate the victims of those crimes. Mr. Mayes was charged with two counts of Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle, two counts of Possession of a Stolen Vehicle, Attempt to Elude-Felony, Identity Theft and Theft in the Second Degree. Mr. Mayes was taken to Washington County Jail.
