Update: Suspicious Circumstance Led To Death Investigation

On November 17, 2018 at 8:45 p.m. Beaverton Police officers were called to 12120 SW Allen Blvd regarding a suspicious circumstance. A deceased body was located at the residence. The state Medical Examiner determined the manner of death to be homicide.

On January 23, 2019, the Oregon State crime lab notified Beaverton Police detectives the deceased was identified as 29-year-old Amy N. Low. A positive identification was determined using DNA testing.

During the course of the investigation, multiple items were seized from the residence, pursuant to search warrants. Evidentiary items have been released to the Oregon State crime lab for DNA testing. DNA test results will help determine further investigative efforts.

No further information can be released at this time because the investigation is ongoing.
