SHELL GAS STATION BURGLARY

Beaverton, Oregon -- Suspects scramble to avoid apprehension during an early morning gas station burglary.

Minutes after 1:00 AM on June 29, 2020 two suspects, 26-year-old Dilyn Ray McReynolds of West Linn and 33-year-old Michael Anthony Collis of Portland entered the Shell Gas Station at 7545 SW Oleson Rd. After gaining access to the interior of the building through the back door, both men climbed into the ceiling and made their way to an area of the building where they would have access to the business' safe.

Despite being equipped with a hydraulic spreader, pry bars, an angle grinder, and a splitting maul, McReynolds and Collis were unable to open the business' safe.

An after-hours alarm alerted police when McReynolds and Collis entered the gas station. Within minutes, officers from the Beaverton Police Department and the Washington County Sherriff's Office arrived. McReynolds and Collis can be seen on surveillance footage scrambling to escape the building to avoid capture.

Both suspects fled the area on foot and were apprehended a short distance away thanks to Beaverton Police canine Atlas and his handler, Officer Coulson.

McReynolds and Collis were lodged into the Washington County Jail on Burglary charges.
