Beaverton Police Seek Identity of Stabbing Suspect

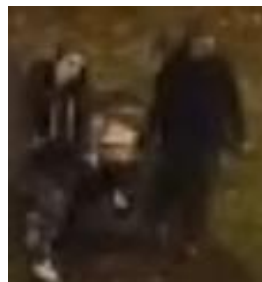
On November 24, 2020 around 11:00 PM, Beaverton Police responded to the report of a stabbing near the intersection of SW Hall Blvd. and SW Colony Lane. An adult male victim suffered multiple stab wounds and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. He has since been released.

The victim told police he was attacked by two males and one female. He explained the female (pictured below) approached him, pulled out a knife, and demanded his cell phone. When the victim didn't comply, she began stabbing him. During the attack she told the victim (who is originally from South America), that she hated Hispanics, and to give up his cell phone.

There were two men with the female when the attack occurred. According to the victim, both men participated in the assault by hitting and kicking him. The confirmed identity of all three suspects remains unknown.

The female suspect is described as a white female in her late 20s, 5'2" tall, 130lbs, with brown shoulder length straight hair, and unknown eye color. A description of the involved men is limited –only that one was tall and one was medium height, and they were both wearing dark clothing.
