Traffic Stop Leads to Drug Arrest

On Saturday, March 20, 2021, Beaverton police officers arrested 44-year-old Apolinar Ramirez of Hillsboro and 39-year-old Rita Sabin of Portland on various drug related charges.

At 10:07 p.m., a BPD officer stopped a vehicle northbound on Hwy 217 near SW Allen Blvd. for suspicion of DUII.

During the course of the DUII investigation, officers located controlled substances to include: Heroin, Fentanyl, MDMA, LSD, Lorazepam (79 pills), Xanax (814 pills) Methamphetamine (1.35 lbs.) and evidence of identification theft.

Mr. Ramirez was charged with: DUII, Felony Driving While Suspended, Possession of a Controlled Substance- Heroin (misdemeanor), Distribution of a Controlled Substance- Methamphetamine, Manufacture of a Controlled Substance- Methamphetamine, Distribution of a Controlled Substance- Heroin, and a Probation Violation.

Ms. Sabin was charged with: Possession of a Controlled Substance-Heroin, Identity Theft, Tampering with Drug Records, Unlawful Manufacture/Delivery of a Controlled Substance, and a Probation Violation.

Both Ms. Sabin and Mr. Ramirez were lodged in the Washington County Jail.
