What is a Cadet?

A Cadet is a civilian volunteer 15 to 20 years of age who is interested in learning and participating in programs concerning specific aspects of law enforcement and the criminal justice system.

Cadets observe and assist in various jobs under direct supervision of sworn police officers. Cadets get hands-on experience and training by participating in police ride-alongs with patrol and traffic enforcement. They also assist in community events.



Who can Apply?

- Anyone 15 to 20 years of age at the time of application.
- Be a high school graduate or be attending high school or college and maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- Possess or have the ability to secure a valid driver's license or permit, and maintain a good driving record.

What is a Cadet Academy?

A Cadet Academy is a condensed version of the State of Oregon Police Academy attended by regular police officers. The Cadet Academy classes are held two evenings a week and some Saturdays. Cadets are trained in all aspects of police work.
