## Requests for Victims of Criminal Activity: U Nonimmigrant Status (U Visa) and Victims of Human Trafficking: T Nonimmigrant Status (T Visa)

To request a Form I-918, Supplement B, U Nonimmigrant Status Certification (U Visa) or a Form I-914, Supplement B, Declaration of Law Enforcement Officer for Victim of Trafficking in Persons (T Visa) from the Beaverton Police Department, the petitioner (immigration attorney, community agency, or individual) should send a letter of request that includes the following information:

- Complete name of the victim, spelled correctly
- Date of birth of the victim
- Date and address/location of the incident
- Beaverton Police Department case number
- Completed I-918, Supplement B, U Nonimmigrant Status Certification (U Visa) form or I-914, Supplement B, Declaration of Law Enforcement Officer for Victim of Trafficking in Persons (T Visa) form
- A birth certificate or proof of guardianship, if a parent/guardian is petitioning for themselves and/or a minor victim
- Copy of the police report and case disposition, if possible
