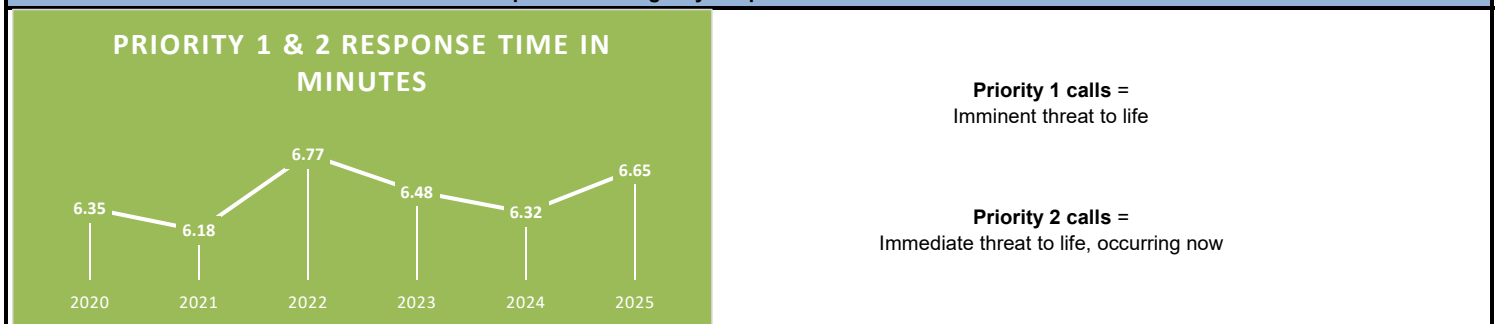

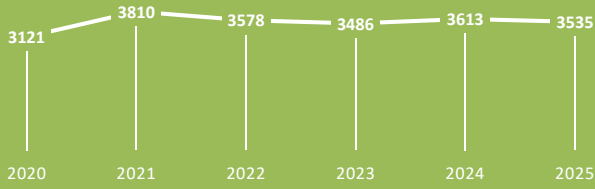

September Emergency Response Times - 6 Year Trend

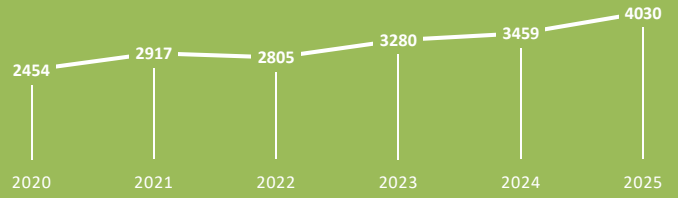


September Calls for Service - by Month: 6 Year Trend
