## What is a Cadet?

A Cadet is a civilian volunteer older than 16 and less than 21 years old who is interested in learning and participating in programs concerning specific aspects of law enforcement and the criminal justice system.

Cadets observe and assist in various jobs under direct supervision of sworn police officers. Cadets get hands-on experience and training by participating with police ride-a-longs, patrol, traffic enforcement, and assist in community events.



## Who can Apply?

- Must be older than 16 and less than 21 years of age at the time of the application.
- Be a high school graduate or be attending high school and maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- Possess or have the ability to immediately secure a valid driver's license or permit, and maintain a good driving record.

## What is a Cadet Academy?

A Cadet Academy is a condensed version of the State of Oregon Police Academy attended by regular police officers. The Cadet Academy classes are held on consecutive Saturdays. Cadets are trained in report writing, drug investigations, firearms, defensive tactics, building searches and other areas of police work.
